Welcome Artists to the 13th Annual Art on the Boulevard and Home & Cottage Tour in Erieau, ON Saturday, August 3, 2024



August 3, 2024 is quickly approaching, and we are really looking forward to the 13th Anniversary of Art on the Boulevard in beautiful downtown Erieau!

Important information to Artists:

- **When you arrive on Saturday, August 3, please visit the information table to check in and to be assigned to your location.** Do NOT go directly to any location and set up before checking in first. Check in begins at 7 a.m. The information table is located beside the Memorial Garden area which is located on the far end of the boulevard. In case of rain, the information table will be set up in the Erieau Firehall.
- The Boulevard is approximately 2 km in length and is tree lined providing ample shade however there are some sunny areas. Due to the natural landscape of the boulevard, assigned spaces will not be equal in size.
- The event begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m., rain or shine. Set up time begins at 7:00 a.m. and pack up at 4:00 p.m. Do not pack up or tear down your display before 4:00 p.m. Electricity is not available.
- Parking for artists is directly behind your assigned location and assessable from Mariners Rd. for easy unloading.
- Please bring your own display equipment and chairs. Displays must be freestanding and not attached to trees, branches or poles. There should be plenty of room for a canopy or display tent, a couple tables (tables are not provided) and a display stand if you wish. Please ensure the canopy or display tent is clean and professional looking with no tears. Tarps are not permitted. Set up equipment 2 feet from the sidewalk to ensure ample room for visitors walking on and beside the sidewalk.
- Washrooms are available at the Erieau Community Centre/Firehall, and the Anglican Church. Portable washrooms are located at the end of the boulevard, at each of the three cross roads, and the Erieau Yacht Club.
- As per the application, refunds will not be given. Raffles, food or refreshments are not to be sold at your display location and you may not display or sell items not listed on your application.
- Water stations are available along the boulevard and the local Neighbourhood Watch will serve coffee and donuts in the morning. Food and refreshments are also available at the following locations: Anglican Church, Erieau Yacht Club, Loretta's Restaurant, Bayside Brewery, Molly and OJ's and the Sandbar. Check the website for further details regarding these organizations and what they have to offer.
- In order to create a brochure that was organized, easy to read and pleasing to the eye, 80 artist names were included. Artist names were added on a first come, first serve basis. If you would like a copy of the brochure, please visit businesses in Erieau, Blenheim or Chatham.

On behalf of the Erieau Community Association and the Art on the Boulevard Planning Committee, I wish you a safe arrival to Erieau on August 3, 2024. The soothing summer breezes await you in Erieau and I look forward to seeing you at the 13th Anniversary of our annual Art on the Boulevard.
